Dr. Corstiaan Breugem President

Corstiaan is professor in the Division of Plastic, Reconstructive Surgery at the University of Amsterdam, the Netherlands. He is pediatric plastic surgeon working in the Emma Children's Hospital in Amsterdam. He is also director of Interplast Holland. This NGO help plastic surgery unit's in Low Income Countries create durable and long lasting care, by training, inspiring and funding plastic surgeons to provide care in their own region.

After obtaining his registration as a plastic and reconstructive surgeon in Amsterdam, he did a pediatric plastic surgery fellowship in Vancouver, Canada 2005/2006. In 2003 he finished his PhD in vascular malformations. After working Utrecht for 12 years, he started working again in Amsterdam in 2019. He has published > 175 peer reviewed articles and has given > 100 international presentations. He has performed > 1000 cleft surgeries. He was initiator of the International Cleft Palate Dissection course.

Dr. Stéphane Guichard Treasurer

Stéphane trained in Paris and spent two years in Buenos Aires as a fellow in general surgery. He was certified in reconstructive and aesthetic surgery both in France and by the European Board of Plastic surgery in 92.

After being a consultant for face reconstruction at Hôpital Saint Louis in Paris, he became Dr. Françoise Firmin's partner and trained with her on a daily basis until she retired in 2018. He has been Senior Consultant at Hôpitaux Universitaire de Genève for EarReconstructions from 2005 to 2019. He has been part of teaching programs and has operated in Colombia, Tunisia, Spain and Italy. As an ISAR Exco Member he would like the ISAR to be a welcoming place for those who want information, teaching and advices .

Dr. Sharon Cushing is a full-time paediatric otolaryngologist and the Director of the Cochlear Implant Program at The Hospital for Sick Children and a full Professor in the Department of Otolaryngology Head and Neck Surgery at the University of Toronto, Canada.

Her research interest includes the developmental impact of hearing, vestibular and balance dysfunction in children, and its association with cochlear and bone conduction implants.

Dr. Ken Stewart President-Elect

Ken graduated from medical school in 1990. He then spent the next 12 years in general surgical training, followed by plastic surgery training. While principally based in Scotland, he also undertook periods of specialist plastic surgery training in Sydney, Toronto and California.

Ken has been on the GMC specialist register in plastic surgery since 2002. He is a full member of BAAPS, BAPRAS, EURAPS and ISAR, and was the first surgeon in Scotland to be Royal College of Surgeons certified in cosmetic surgery. He is often invited to lecture at prestigious surgical societies both in the UK (BAPRAS, ENT UK, BOAMS, BOPS) and abroad in China, India, Ireland, Switzerland and Poland. He has also, by invitation, performed live demonstration surgery overseas in Poland, Oman, India and this year Vietnam. He recently visited Ukraine to assist with reconstructive surgeries and provide training and support to Ukrainian doctors who have been impacted by the ongoing conflict.

Ken is a training programme director for plastic surgery in Scotland and an honorary senior lecturer at Edinburgh University as well as an NHS consultant surgeon at the Royal Hospital for Sick Children and St Johns. In the NHS he undertakes complex reconstructive surgery of the face, ear and body.
